### Volunteer Release & Safety Pledge

*Mini-Miracle Day* is a volunteer program sponsored by The Christian Church of Northern California-Nevada (collectively, the "Sponsors") to perform needed cleaning, maintenance, repair and construction work for congregations and other related entities of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) who may not be able to accomplish this work on their own. Such work may involve hard physical labor, lifting, and other strenuous activities, some of which may take place on ladders, scaffolds and other locations above or below ground.

I desire to participate in *Mini-Miracle Day* by volunteering my time and talents. As a condition to my participation, I agree to the following:

1. I acknowledge that the work I will perform may be strenuous and could result in injury, and I accept full responsibility for all bodily injury or personal injury which I may sustain, and agree for myself and for my estate and heirs to release, discharge and indemnify and forever hold the Sponsors and the congregation or other organization on whose property I may be working harmless from any and all causes of action and claims which I may, at any time, have as a result of my voluntary participation in *Mini-Miracle Day*. I further acknowledge that any work I perform is strictly voluntary, and that I have the right to refuse to perform and will in fact not perform any work which is beyond my capability or physical ability.
2. I agree that I will abide by any rules and regulations that may be established in conjunction with the *Mini-Miracle Day* project on which I have been chosen to volunteer.
3. I acknowledge that on *Mini-Miracle Day*, the Sponsors may make photographic and/or video recordings of all or a portion of any Mini-Miracle Day (Photos and Recordings"), which could include my image or likeness and I understand that such Photos and Recordings may be included in video tapes, books, booklets, brochures, displays and electronic media which may be published or otherwise made available to the general public. I hereby consent to such Photos and Recordings and waive any and all rights to compensation for the use of such Photos and Recordings.

At Mini-Miracle Day we want to promote an atmosphere of safety for all. Please read and sign below to show that you agree to participate in keeping everyone safe at Mini-Miracle Day.

1. I will bring the following items with me.
  - a. Water bottle: Will be able to refill it throughout the day on site.
  - b. Sunscreen, hat, sunglasses if working outside.
  - c. Closed toed shoes
  - d. Personal protective equipment if available: work gloves, goggles, ear plugs, respirator, rubber gloves, hard hat.
2. Tool Inspection: I will submit my tools for inspection before starting work. (Tools should be clean, sharp, no frayed electrical wires, etc.)
3. Prevent Injury: If I see a dangerous situation I will stop, pay attention and do or say something to make the situation safer.
4. Treat Injury: If I experience an injury or if I see an injury happen I will go, or help the injured person go, to the first-aid station.
5. Know and respect my limits: It will be a hot day. I'll drink water to stay hydrated and only do work that is consistent with my physical capabilities. I'll ask for help when a job is too big for me alone.
6. Personal protective equipment: When asked by a supervisor, I will use whatever protective gear is required.
7. I will use the right tool for the job (e.g., Use a ladder NOT a folding chair to reach heights).
8. Clean workspace: I will leave my worksite clean, pick up all materials and tools and return them to the tool room at the end of the day.
